BLOOMING

During the first few weeks after the composite material is exposed to the outdoors, Kodiak Composite Decking may experience a light brown-yellow color shift. This shift occurs because the natural wood fibers found in composite decking begins to oxidize or Bloom.

“Blooming” is noticed in the grey family of colors more than others. The amount of time it takes for blooming to occur varies, depending on weather conditions and exposure to direct sunlight. However, this process rarely takes longer than four weeks, after which Kodiak returns to its natural weathering process. (New England Grey Shown)
